Causes of the Antebellum Spirit of Reform

What is "Antebellum"?

- Antebellum = Ante + Bellum
 - Ante = Before
 - Bellum = War
 - Antebellum = Before the war
 - In US History
 - usually before the Civil War (1861-1865)
 - 1820ish → 1860ish



What is "Reform"?

- Reform = Re + Form
 - Reform = to make again
 - To fix or improve



What is "Antebellum Reform"?

 General spirit of improvement in America from 1820-1860ish

Reaction to the many changes happening at the time

continental nation spanning from Atlantic to Pacific






Socially: Second Great Awakening
