## What is Progressivism?

- Social Movement
- Response to Profound Changes of 1800s
  - Industrialization, Rise of Big Business
    & Robber Barons/Captains of Industry
  - o Populism; Labor Conflict
- When: c1890 c1920
- Felt at all levels of society & government
  - Local → State → National

### What is a Social Movement?

- Broad Based—lots of different kinds of people involved
- Grass Roots—Starts locally but grows to state & national levels
- Reform—Fix society

 Movement—not comprehensively unified (leadership, organization, goals)

### Forward-Looking (Progress...ive)

- Liked Industrialization
- Did *not* want to return to agrarian past
- Only wanted to correct evils and abuses of Gilded Age
  - Concentration of Wealth & Power
  - Disruption of Populism & Labor Conflicts
- Believed in science & engineering and ability of *experts* to solve problems
