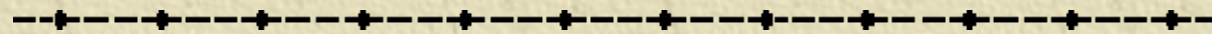

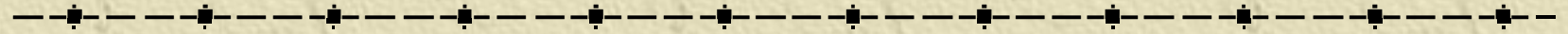
# Demographically Parted

✧ Mean Population Center: Columbus, IN

Total Population	63 Million	100%
White	55 Million	87.5%
Black	7.5 Million	12%
Native Amer.	250 Thousand	.4%
Asian	110 Thousand	.1%
Foreign Born	9.2 Million	15%
Rural	41 Million	66%
Urban	22 Million	34%

# Regionally Parted: Northeast

---

## ✦ Big Idea: Industrialization

- ◆ Most Populous
- ◆ Economic Center
- ◆ Urbanized
  - 8 of top 10 cities by population



# Regionally Parted: Southeast

---

## ✦ Big Idea: Jim Crow

- ◆ Reconstruction “ended”
- ◆ Some Economic Recovery--  
Agricultural
- ◆ White Supremacy Restored
  - Disenfranchisement
  - *De Jure* Segregation

# Regionally Parted: West

---

## ✦ Big Idea: Closing of the Frontier

- ◆ West Conquered & Settled

- End of Indian Wars (Wounded Knee)

- ◆ 1890 Census-No Frontier

- Frederick Jackson Turner

- ◆ Populism



# PEGS Parted

- ✧ Politically—Small Gov't
  - ✧ Economically—Industrial but Depressed

# PEGS Parted: Political

---

## ✦ Big Idea: Small Gov't

- ◆ Party: Close but Republican dominance
- ◆ Federal: B Harrison (R) pres, (R) Congress
  - Isolationist & Protectionist
- ◆ City: Lots of Corruption
  - Political Machines



# PEGS Parted: Economic

---

## ✦ Big Idea: Industrial but Depressed

- ◆ Fully Industrialized
- ◆ Most productive economy
- ◆ Rise of Big Business
  - Corporations
  - Trusts
- ◆ Panic of 1893
- ◆ Labor Conflict
  - Homestead & Pullman Strikes
  - Haymarket Affair

# PEGS Parted: Geographic

---

## ✧ Big Idea: continental nation

- ◆ Current Boundaries
- ◆ 42 States (Jan 1890)
- ◆ ID & WY (July 1890)
- ◆ Primarily Rural, Increasingly Urban
- ◆ Density flows NE→SE→West
- ◆ Increasingly interconnected via RR network



# PEGS Parted: Social

---

## ✦ Big Idea: Divided Society

### ◆ Gender

- Women had few legal rights, economic opportunities

### ◆ Race

- Segregation: *De Jure & De Facto*
  - ◆ Plessy vs. Ferguson
- Chinese Exclusion Act

### ◆ Class

- Huge Disparity of Wealth
