

# “Other” Civil Rights Movements Jigsaw

**Overview:** In this activity, we will explore numerous civil rights movements that were more or less inspired/influenced by the African-American Civil Rights Movement. You will work with 2-4 other students. Each of you will gather information about a particular American demographic group and that group’s civil rights movement. You will work cooperatively in class to organize that information and create a Google Slide presentation to share with your classmates.

## Demographic Groups:

1. Asian-Americans
2. American Indians
3. Hispanic-Americans
4. Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transexual, Queer, Intersexual, Asexual (LGBTQIA) Americans
5. Women

**Research:** Each individual student will do independent research to gather information on your demographic group. Relevant information is from the 2nd half of the 20th century. Accordingly, each student should complete an [“Other” Civil Rights Movements Worksheet](#). Research needs to come from quality sources. Be sure to include bibliographic information on the second page of worksheet.

**Google Slide:** Working cooperatively with the other students who have the same demographic group, you will create a Google Slide that meets the following expectations:

- Is in the class Google folder (and therefore accessible by all members of the class)
- At least 5 well-organized slides including each of the following:
  - Title Slide
  - Thesis Slide
  - Bibliography Slide
- Additionally Google Slides presentation should meet the following expectations:
  - Important info (Key Events, Leaders, Organizations, Documents, Ideas & Slogans)
  - Meaningfully organized (Shouldn’t just have a slide each for “Events”, “Leaders”, etc.)
  - Clearly written but not too texty
  - Uses visuals but not too busy or razzle-dazzly
